## Tradition and passion – an invitation for enjoyment!

The small romantic wine town Burkheim is found at the west edge of the Kaiserstuhl in direct proximity to the Rhine. The fauna and flora of this sunny and attractive landscape is a paradise for nature friends. The first safe message over the local wine growing comes from 24th, June 778. With this early mention Burkheim is one of the oldest viticulture municipalities at the Kaiserstuhl (Baden / Germany). October in 1924 with 44 members and about 65 hectare of growing area. Today 40 winegrower families manage about 116 hectare of growing area. To protect the environment, our winegrowers don't use insecticides. On the deep loess of the individual layer "Schlossgarten" and the volcanic rock of the individual layer "Feuerberg", outstanding wines are growing in sun-flooded places. They already furnished high ranges of 290° Oechsle. The high quality of our wines is proved by the honors, we permanently receive of:
